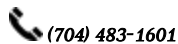

Sermon Series:

Sticks and Stones Are Not the Problem



This is the final week of our series called "Sticks and Stones Are Not the Problem." The concept comes from the children's rhyme, "Sticks and stones may break my bones but words will never hurt me." This rhyme is a blatant lie. Words are often the most painful weapons we can use against each other. How many of us are carrying deep and hurtful wounds caused by someone's malicious words uttered years ago. This series is a reminder that our behavior matters and through Christ we are called to pay close attention to what comes out of our mouths as a leading indicator of what is in our hearts.
